# Jesus saves us from lies and counterfeit "saviors"

In the same way that treating symptoms doesn't actually *heal*, some things do help, but they don't truly *save*. Addictions and lies imprison us—even when we could be free! In every area of our life, we must look to Jesus and shout *Hosanna*, which means "save us, The Only Savior Who Can!"
